BOIL WATER NOTICE RESCINDED

JULY 19, 2018

On July 18, 2018, The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality required the City of Kemp public water system, TX1290004, to issue a Boil Water Notice to inform customers, individuals or employees that due to conditions that occurred recently in the public water system, the water from this public water system was required to be boiled prior to use for drinking water or human consumption purposes.

The public water system has taken the necessary corrective actions to restore the quality of the water distributed by this public water system used for drinking water or human consumption purposes and has provided TCEQ with laboratory test results that indicate that the water no longer requires boiling prior to uses as of July 19, 2018.
